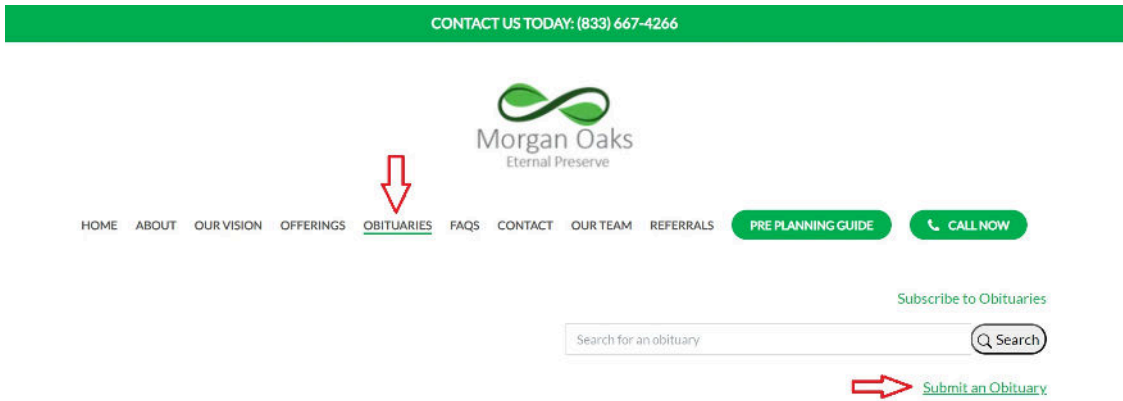
Obituary submission page is now available on our website!

Northern Harrier



Morgan Oaks is a habitat to many animals, including the Northern Harrier.
