What is Green Burial?



The body is not preserved with chemicals and may be encased in a biodegradable coffin (often made of untreated softwood) or cloth shroud, and then placed into a grave without an outer vault or container that would prevent soil contact.

Gopher Snake



Morgan Oaks is a habitat to many animals, including Gopher Snakes.

- **Effective Mimics**: Gopher snakes are skilled mimics and can imitate the rattle of a rattlesnake by vibrating their tail against dry leaves or grass. This behavior helps them to deter predators by making them appear more dangerous than they actually are.
- Impressive Size: Some species of gopher snakes, such as the bullsnake, can grow to impressive lengths of up to 6 feet or more. They are one of the largest native snake species in North America.
- Non-Venomous Constrictors: Gopher snakes are non-venomous constrictors, meaning they kill their prey by squeezing it until it suffocates. They then swallow their prey whole, aided by their flexible jaws which allow them to consume prey much larger than their head.
- Long Lifespan: In the wild, gopher snakes can live for over 15 years, while in captivity they can live even longer, sometimes up to 30 years or more with proper care.
