Grilled Corn & Peach Salad with Basil & Feta

A fresh and flavorful dish that's perfect for your Labor Day gathering—whether you're relaxing under the oaks or hosting loved ones at home.

Ingredients:

- 4 ears of corn, husked
- 2–3 ripe peaches, sliced
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- ullet 1/2 small red onion, thinly sliced
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup crumbled feta cheese
- A handful of fresh basil leaves, torn
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 1 tbsp balsamic glaze or white balsamic vinegar
- Salt & pepper to taste

Instructions:

- 1.Grill the corn over medium heat until lightly charred (about 10 minutes). Let cool slightly and slice off the kernels.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine corn, peaches, cherry tomatoes, and red onion.
- 3. Drizzle with olive oil and balsamic. Season with salt and pepper.
- 4.Toss gently to combine, then top with feta and fresh basil.

Serve immediately or chill until ready.
