Harvest Cranberry Pecan Crisp Ingredients (serves 6–8):

2 cups diced apples or pears
2 cups fresh or frozen cranberries
1/3 cup maple syrup or honey
1 tsp cinnamon, 1/2 tsp allspice,
pinch salt

Topping:

3/4 cup oats, 1/4 cup flour
1/4 cup chopped pecans
1/4 cup brown sugar, 1/4 cup
melted butter
1/2 tsp cinnamon, pinch salt

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350°F.
Mix fruit, syrup, and spices; spread
in greased dish.
Combine topping ingredients;
sprinkle over fruit.
Bake 35–40 min until golden &
bubbly.

*Optional: serve warm with vanilla ice cream
or whipped cream.*
